### **CCOP PATROL REPORT: FRIDAY 01/23/2015 Roving Foot Patrol (RFP) – 21:30-24:00**

#### **CONDITIONS:**

Not noted by team.

#### **NOTABLE INCIDENTS:**

- **22:12 HRS EUREKA VALLEY / HARVEY MILK LIBRARY PARKING LOT – Safety Advisory:** There was a BFA sitting in her car reading and I asked the rest of the group if she was allowed to be in her car in this parking lot. I got the okay from 2 of the other patrollers so I advised her that it probably isn't the safest place to be reading at night and told her to just be alert and safe. HFA in her 20s sitting in a different car was also just hanging out with the window down halfway. I advised her to do the same and to be careful sitting in her car at night.
- **22:42 HRS WALGREENS PARKING LOT – Auto Strip/Boost (852):** There was a broken backseat-passenger side window on a Nissan SUV with the license plate "██████████". Patroller Kyle W. called the non-emergency SFPD line. Operator was a female, she asked if it was my car and after I said no, she told

me there's nothing I can do to report it if I am not the owner of the vehicle. She stated that the owner needs to be the one to report if anything is stolen from the vehicle so they can create a list of the items and their value in order to file an official report. I asked if I can at least put something on record that we found the vehicle in this condition and if maybe I should call 311 instead but she was reluctant to provide any assistance to me.

- **10:55 HRS 18<sup>TH</sup> ST & CASTRO ST – Intoxicated Person (811):** The CCOP group greeted SFPD at 18<sup>th</sup> and Castro. The SFPD officers were taking care of a intoxicated man.
- **23:00 HRS CASTRO THEATRE PARKING LOT – Trespass (601):** There was a man sleeping on the ground at the Castro Theater parking lot. Patrollers informed the man to move but the man didn't move. Team Leader called Patrol Special Police and Officer Fitzinger responded. The man left the parking lot at the direction of Officer Fitzinger.
- **23:31 HRS COLLINGWOD STREET & MARKET STREET – Intoxicated Person (811):** The CCOP group noticed a man putting another intoxicated man into the back seat of a SUV, a White 4 door Fiat 500L with a Nevada License plate [REDACTED] at Collinwood and Market. Patrollers approached the sober man who advised "I'm helping my drunk friend get home," with a Spanish accent. When we inquired if the intoxicated man knew the other he replied "No. I don't know where I am. I don't know him." Patrollers escorted the intoxicated man away from the sober individual. The sober individual actually directed Patrollers to a female friend of the intoxicated male who was at Badlands bar. The female friend immediately came outside and the intoxicated man acknowledged that she was a friend and didn't need any more assistance. The sober male disappeared back into Badlands.
- **23:50 HRS 00 BLOCK DIAMOND ST @ 18<sup>TH</sup> ST – Well Being Check (910):** Man with a dog sleeping on top of him. We flashed the light near him but the dog began growling as soon as we took a step in the direction. From a distance we asked if he needed any kind of assistance and he shook his head no.
