### **CCOP PATROL REPORT: SATURDAY 05/16/2015**

#### **Roving Foot Patrol (RFP) - 23:00-00:30**

CCOP Patrollers have donated a total of 531 hours to the community year to date.

**SFPD OVERTIME 10b OFFICER ASSIGNED:** No Officer showed up for this assigned shift.

#### **CONDITIONS:**

Conditions: Clear and cold, with temperatures in the low 50s, winds 15-20mph and good visibility.

#### **NOTABLE INCIDENTS:**

- **23:00 HRS Start of Patrol at Chevron Station, Market and Castro Streets.**
- **23:23 HRS 400 Block Castro Street - Trespass (MPC 25):** WMA sleeping in business doorway. We conducted a well being check. Subject refused HOT and medical assistance. Advised about the posted no trespassing sign and complied.

- **23:29 HRS Walgreens Parking Lot - Trespass (601):** WMA and BMA loitering in the North East corner of the lot adjacent to Collingwood Street. Both subjects refused HOT and medical assistance. Advised and both complied heading North on Collingwood Street.
- **23:55 HRS 300 Block Noe Street – Well Being Check (910):** BMA sleeping in the doorway of a business. Conducted well being check. Subject refused HOT and medical assistance.
- **23:56 HRS 300 Block Noe – Trespass (MPC-25):** WMA sleeping in business doorway. Conducted a well being check. Subject refused HOT and medical assistance. Advised subject of the no trespassing sign and he complied.
- **00:01 HRS 400 Block Noe Street – Theft of Recyclables (SFHC 313):** While patrolling South on Noe Street we observed a shopping cart filled with empty bottles and cans discarded part way into a residence driveway. As we investigated we observed a BMA within the garden of the residence removing items from the garbage cans. We advised him to leave immediately, admonished him and advised he would be arrested for trespass and petty theft if we found him doing so again. He apologized and promised not to do so again.
- **00:10 HRS 444 Castro Street – Trespass (MPC-25):** WMA lying on the ground at the entrance to Citi Bank directly under the no trespassing sign. Subject refused HOT and medical assistance. We advised him and he complied heading South on Castro Street.
- **00:11 HRS 444 Castro Street – Loitering ():** WMA loitering next to the Citi Bank ATM's. We advised him and he complied.
- **00:16 HRS 2400 Block 17<sup>th</sup> Street – Trespass (601):** JMA sleeping on the ground inside an open garage area to a private residence. We conducted a well being check. Subject refused HOT and medical assistance. We advised him and he complied heading East on 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Disposition: ADV

**00:30 HRS End of Patrol** – As the neighborhood was so unusually quiet, we decided to demobilize the patrol earlier than scheduled.

**OTHER ITEMS OF NOTE:**

- Passing calls included: Badlands, 440, Midnight Sun, Q-Bar, The Café, JD Liquors, 7-11, Noe Street Market. We conducted 2 checks of the Castro Theatre parking lot, 1 check of the Walgreens parking lot, 1 check of the MUNI station, 1 check of the Pink Triangle Park, 3 checks of JWP and 2 checks of HMP.
