CASTRO CARES SFPD 10b OFFICER: 10b Officer was expected on duty prior to our patrol deployment.

CONDITIONS:

Warm with good visibility. Temperatures ranged fro 63 down to 59 degrees.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS:

•23:00 HRS Start of Patrol

- **23:20 HRS, 18th Street & Castro Street, Member of Public Report (909):** WMA approached our team to advise he believed a WFA nearby may be “in trouble” as the WMA with her was “hassling” her. We approached the WFA, confirmed that she was o.k. and the WMA was known to her. Disposition: ND
- **23:21 HRS, 470 Castro Street, Well Being Check (910):** BMA sleeping inside a sleeping bag adjacent to the entry door to the closed store. No MPC025 posted. Individual refused HOT and medical services. Disposition: NCR
- **23:35 HRS, 1 Jose Sarria Ct. Parking Lot, Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping inside a sleeping bag at the back of the library parking lot. Individual refused HOT and medical services. Advised he was trespassing per the MPC-25 posted but subject refused to leave. Disposition: ADV
- **23:45 HRS, 411 Sanchez Street, Well Being Check (910):** HMA sleeping in a sleeping bag next to the garage door of a private residence. Individual refused HOT and medical services. Advised he was trespassing on private residence property and he complied. Disposition: ADV
- **23:55 HRS, Noe Street & 18th Street, Well Being check (910):** WMA sleeping on the sidewalk. Individual refused HOT and medical services. Disposition: NCR
- **24:00 HRS, 4049 18th Street, Intoxicated Person (811):** We observed two HMA’s assisting a very intoxicated third HMA who was being supported by the two. We approached, determined the intoxicated person knew the other two and that he was willing to go home with them. Both agreed to ensure he got home safely. Disposition: NCR
- **00:05 HRS, 24 Hartford Street, Open Container (21):** We

- observed two WMA's sitting on the steps of the private residence drinking directly from a bottle of wine. We inquired if either resided at the residence. As neither did we advised them of the open container law and they complied by pouring out the remaining wine and leaving the area. Disposition: ADV
- **00:25 HRS, Walgreens Parking Lot, Trespass (601):** We advised several people loitering in their parked vehicles of the no loitering ordinance and all complied or advised they would be leaving soon. We observed one vehicle with a broken rear driver side quarter panel window, and broke window glass on the ground in another location within the lot. Disposition: ADV
 - **00:31 HRS, 19th Street at Diamond Street, Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping in a sleeping bag against the wall to the baseball field at Eureka Valley Recreation Center. Individual refused HOT and medical services. Disposition: NCR
 - **00:40 HRS, 4180 18th Street, Intoxicated Person (811):** We observed a HMA and WMA assisting a very intoxicated HMA between them as they made their way West on 18th Street. We confirmed the intoxicated person knew his two companions and that he was not medically compromised by his intoxication. His companions promised to get him home safety. Disposition: NCR
 - **00:41 HRS, 4111 18th Street, Illegal Hot Dog Vendor ():** We observed two HMA's removing a portable hot dog cooking station from a black GMC with CA plate **5 TNB 694**. We inquired about their sales permit, which they advised they did not have. We advised them they could not sell without one and cautioned that if they did, their hot dog station could be impounded and they would receive a citation. They began to break down the station and leave the area. Disposition: ADV
 - **01:10 HRS, 2310 Market Street, Well Being Check (910):** BFA sitting in the doorway of the store inside a cardboard box base. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance. No MPC-25 posted. Disposition: NCR
 - **01:16 HRS, 2344 Market Street, Intoxicated Person (811):** Observed a WMA sitting on the kurb in what we confirmed to be an intoxicated condition. A WMA friend approached as we spoke with

the individual and we confirmed the intoxicated individual knew the friend. The friend promised to get the intoxicated individual home safely. Disposition: NCR

- **01:20 HRS, 2350 Market Street, Petty Theft (488):** Initially we observed a WFA shouting at a WMA and telling him to leave her the f#@ \$ alone. We approached, identified ourselves and female slowly calmed down and advised she had either lost her cell phone in her Uber ride, or it may have been stolen in the bar. She was extremely upset as it had pictures of her daughter in it. The WMA was her boyfriend who was simply trying to calm her down at the time. We found that the "find my i-phone" function did not locate the individuals phone, so we advised her to report the loss or theft to Mission Police Station at her earliest opportunity. Unfortunately she did not have any serial number or other identifying information for the lost/stolen phone. Disposition: ADV
- **01:35 HRS, 4100 18th Street, Urinating In Public (153):** As we patrolled East on the North side of 18th, we observed a WMA open his pants fly and presumed he was about to urinate against the Walgreens wall by the bus shelter. We contacted him and admonished him to find a more suitable place to relieve himself. He left Westbound on 18th Street. Disposition: ADM
- **01:40 HRS, Harvey Milk Plaza, Sleeping In Plaza (Park Code 3.13):** WMA sleeping in a sleeping bag in the third recessed area on the upper level of Harvey Milk Plaza. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance and advised he was just waiting for his girlfriend. We advised him of the no sleeping in the plaza ordinance, but advised he could sit and wait in the Plaza if he wished. Disposition: ADV
- **01:41 HRS, Harvey Milk Plaza, Upper Level Plaza Lights Out :** As we were approaching the person above, we noticed the pedestrian walk-way lights on the upper level of the Plaza were not on. We reported this to 3-1-1, report # 5022636. Disposition: REP
- **01:50 HRS, 2300 Market Street @ Jane Warner Plaza, Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping in a sleeping bag on the sidewalk adjacent to the concrete planter box on Market Street. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance. Disposition: NCR

- **01:56 HRS, 419 Castro Street, Assault/Battery (240):** Two AMA's involved in a verbal altercation. When we approached one AMA claimed to have been slapped in the face twice by another AMA. Victim however advised he did not want to press charges and did not require medical attention. Victim left of his own accord.
Disposition: ABA
- **02:03 HRS, 493 Castro Street, Person Down (914):** We observed a BMA lying face down on the pavement close to the kurb line. We made several attempts to rouse him before he finally responded. Clearly intoxicated and very confused he initially advised us he knew he was currently in Atlanta, then advised he had "no idea" how he came to be in San Francisco or where he was staying in the city. As we continued to question him to try to extract some useful information two WFA's showed up claiming to be his friend. While he initially provided us with the wrong name for the WFA, he did ultimately advise he knew her and was happy to go home with her. Victim was **Shomary Lacy**. WFA friend was **Mena Tajiri** DoB 07/18/1988 document with CA DL.
