**NOTABLE INCIDENTS:**

**21:30 HRS: Start of Patrol.**

**21:45 HRS: Exit 150 Eureka to start patrol.**

**21:55 HRS: Passing Call 4001 19th St. NOE MARKET** - Store clerk expressed concern about an ongoing problem around 3:00am, with racing cars up and down Noe St as well as kids screaming and making noise.

**22:15 HRS: Passing Call 3998 18th St. 7-Eleven** - Store clerks everything was quiet this evening

**22:28 HRS:** As we were walking North on Noe St at 18th St., **TPtr. Wilson** noticed a suspicious looking man in a hoodie walking along side cars and peering into the windows so we double backed but we lost him. We did happen to be approached by a gentleman who expressed concern about vagrants sleeping on the sidewalk. We gave him some literature and a whistle and general information about Castro Cares.

**22:45 HRS: 276 Noe St, Liquor Store - Passing Call -**

**23:16 HRS: Castro Theater Parking Lot, 457 Castro Street -** The gate to the Castro Theater back lot was ajar where big production boxes from Island Creative stage equipment and lighting were being stored for the event that was about to end. A few minutes later a WMA approached us and said he was watching the equipment but needed a quick break to get pizza. We expressed our safety concerns regarding the unlocked gate is a potential for thieves.

**23:24 HRS: 445 Castro St., CVS Pharmacy - Trespassing (601) WMA** sleeping in the doorway. We woke him up and asked him to move and he complied without incident.

**23:34 HRS: Walgreens 498 Castro St., - Blocking Crosswalk - WMA** homeless man passed out/sleeping between the utility pole and the traffic light with his legs blocking the sidewalk and yellow wheel chair ramp. We asked him to move and he complied mumbling mental jibberish as he walked away.

**23:35 HRS: Muni Bus Stop, 18th & Castro - Uber driver license plate 7MYG203** blocking bus stop lane.

**23:42 HRS: Walgreens Parking lot - 1 WMA's and 1 BMA** with a shopping cart loitering and picking through the trash. We advised them of the City's no loitering laws. They stood fast and ignored our pleas to kindly move along. Seeing as they were being defiant and verbally abusive we contacted PS Police and walked across Collingwood St to keep a safe distance. Officer Fitzinger showed up and they dispersed in opposite directions.
