**CONDITIONS:**

The weather was cool with intermittent light rain showers and temperatures in the lower 60s.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS**

- **23:09 Hrs, Castro Muni Station Garden, TRESPASS (601):** WMA camping on one of the terraces of the enclosed garden adjacent to the MUNI entrance, under the pedestrian overpass. Advised he was trespassing and would have to leave. Refused medical and HOT assistance. Began to pack up his belongings as we left. DISPOSITION: ADV
- **23:15 Hrs, 444 Castro Street, LOITERING BY ATM ():** 3x WMA's smoking by the BofA ATM's. Advised of the State Law and requested they apologized and complied. DISPOSITION: ADV
- **23:20 Hrs, Walgreens Parking Lot, LIGHT OUT ():** Observed that a light in the North East corner of the lot continues to work only intermittently, leaving the lot quite dark on the 18<sup>th</sup> Street side when it is not operating. This has been reported to 311, and closes as a ticket a number of times, but the problem persists. We will contact the City directly for a better resolution. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **23:40 Hrs, Castro Theatre Entrance, WELL BEING CHECK (910):** Numerous homeless individuals sleeping and hanging out at the entrance to the theatre. Conducted a well being check on all individuals. All refused medical and HOT assistance. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **24:00 Hrs,** CCOP Patrol split into two separate teams.
- **00:10 Hrs, Castro Muni Station Garden, TRESPASS (601):** CCOP Team #2 requested back-up from Team #1 to remove two WMA trespassing in the same location in the garden. It turned out to be the same person as the 23:09 incident and another individual known to CCOP for trespassing and sleeping in the garden. Both were advised to leave and we remained in place until both had done so. DISPOSITION: ADM
- **00:29 Hrs, 2239 Market Street, WELL BEING CHECK (910):** WMA sleeping in a wheelchair with an umbrella up to protect him from the rain. We conducted a well being check. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **00:30 Hrs, 2233 Market Street, WELL BEING CHECK (910):** WMA sleeping in the doorway of a closed business. We conducted a well being check. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **00:49 Hrs. 139 Noe Street, WELL BEING CHECK (910):** WMA sleeping on a bench. We conducted a well being check. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **00:55 Hrs, Market Street & 16<sup>th</sup> Street, SUSPICIOUS PERSON (917):** As we patrolled West on the North side of Market Street and waited at the stop light at 16<sup>th</sup> Street, we observed a WMA without a shirt running West along Market and turning North on 16<sup>th</sup>, running up the hill. Subject appeared to be barefoot, wearing only blue jeans. We started to make our way up 16<sup>th</sup> to keep an eye on him and to ensure he was ok, but he continued to run up 16<sup>th</sup>, turning North on Castro Street. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **00:56 Hrs. 3624 16<sup>TH</sup> Street, URINATING IN PUBLIC (153):** As we proceeded up 16<sup>th</sup> Street in response to the prior 00:55 incident, we observed a WMA urinating against the wheel of a parked van. We admonished the individual from the opposite side of the street, and he left, heading towards Market Street. DISPOSITION: ADM
- **01:16 Hrs, Market Street @ Castro Street, STREET SIGN KNOCKED DOWN ():** We observed a street sign which had been knocked down on the small island which

separates Market Street just West of Castro Street. We used the 311 on-line application to report it. DISPOSITION: NCR

- **01:24 Hrs, Castro Street @ 18<sup>th</sup> Street, STREET SIGN KNOCKED DOWN ():** We observed a street sign which had been knocked down outside of the Walgreens store. We used the 311 on-line application to report it. DISPOSITION: NCR
