CCOP PATROL REPORT: FRIDAY 03/25/2016
Roving Foot Patrol (RFP) Team #1 - 21:00-22:30

CONDITIONS:

The weather was clear with temperatures in the lower 50s.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS

21:00 Hrs Start of Patrol

- **21:20 Hrs 2300 BLOCK MARKET STREET – Parking Violation (587):** Honda Civic CA [REDACTED] double parked and blocking the bicycle lane with its hazard lights activated but no-one in the vehicle. As we began to investigate, a WMA sitting in a legally parked vehicle which was blocked by the double parked vehicle advised he had been stuck there for a few minutes. WFA finally returned about five minutes later. DISPOSITION: ADM
- **21:25 Hrs 2300 BLOCK MARKET STREET – Wellbeing Check (910):** BMA sleeping by an emergency exit next to the Wells Fargo ATMs. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. We advised him of the State Law regarding loitering in proximity to ATMs and he complied. DISPOSITION: ADV

- **21:40 Hrs 00 BLOCK NOE STREET – Wellbeing Check (910):** WMA sleeping in a sleeping bag on the sidewalk close to parked vehicles adjacent to CPMC Davies Hospital. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **22:55 Hrs 200 BLOCK SANCHEZ STREET – Wellbeing Check (910):** WMA sleeping in a sleeping bag off the sidewalk in a dark area used for parking. Subject refused medical and HOT assistance. We cautioned the subject that vehicles may park in the area, and there was little additional lighting, so there was a risk he may be struck by parking vehicles who may not realize he is there. DISPOSITION: NCR
- **22:10 Hrs 4000 BLOCK 18TH STREET – Trespass (601):** Observed an individual sleeping within the garden area of a private residence on 18th Street by Hartford Street. We were about to rouse the individual to conduct a well being check and advise them of the trespass when we noticed a homeless resources brochure on the ground next to him. Suspecting our other patrol team had already made contact with him, we confirmed this by two way radio, so we left him to sleep. DISPOSITION: NCR
