CONDITIONS:

Warm and clear with good visibility.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS:

- **TEAM DEPLOYED 23:00**

- **23:20 538 CASTRO STREET – Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping inside the doorway of a closed store. No MPC25 posted. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **23:30 CASTRO THEATRE LOT – Trespass (601):** WMA sitting in a Toyota CA [REDACTED]. Advised of the no loitering ordinance and the individual advised he would be leaving as soon as his friend returned from a store. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **23:39 444 CASTRO STREET – Amplified Sound (43):** Two WMA's with electric guitars and an amplification speaker were located at the doors to the bank, but were not playing. We advised them they could play acoustically, but not using the amplifier and asked them to re-locate to the curb side rather than standing next to the ATM machines. Both complied willingly. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **23:40 HARVEY MILK PLAZA – Smoking in Plaza (191):** BMA smoking within the plaza. We advised him of the ordinance and he willingly complied by leaving the plaza. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **23:45 JANE WARNER PLAZA – Camping in Plaza (Parks 3.12):** WFA lying in a sleeping bag in the North West corner of the plaza. We roused her and advised she could not sleep within the Plaza. She complied and left the plaza. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **00:01 00 BLOCK HARTFORD STREET – Well Being Check (910):** WFA & BMA sleeping between two trees at the North East end of the street. Conducted a well being check and both refused HOT and medical assistance. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **00:05 00 BLOCK HARTFORD STREET – Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping on a mattress placed between two trees at the South East end of the street. Conducted a well being check. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **00:06 00 BLOCK HARTFORD STREET – Well Being Check (910):** BFA crying aloud at the South West corner of Hartford Street. Approached to ensure she was ok and individual acknowledged us but asked us to leave. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **00:15 WALGREENS PARKING LOT BY COLLINGWOOD – Open Container (21):** Large group of BFA's sitting at the entrance to the parking lot with a large container of Tequila. Advised and they complied by putting the Tequila into the trunk of a nearby vehicle. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **00:16 WALGREENS PARKING LOT – MID LOT – Trespass (601):** Large group of AMA chatting by a vehicle within the lot. Advised them of

the loitering ordinance and they complied willingly leaving the lot on foot.
DISPOSITION: ADV

- **00:25 HARVEY MILK PLAZA - Camping in Plaza (Parks 3.12):** WFA lying in a sleeping bag in the North East corner of the plaza. We roused her and it turned out to be the same individual we roused in Jane Warner Plaza earlier. We again advised that she could not sleep within the Plaza. She complied grudgingly and left the plaza. **DISPOSITION: ADV**
- **00:40 00 PROSPER STREET – Trespass (601):** Observed what we believed was someone camping in a fire exit lane which was contained between two fences and a locked gate on Prosper Street. Attempted to make contact but received no response, so we climbed the fence to open the gate. Turned out to only be property but no person present. **DISPOSITION: GOA**
- **00:45 3888 17th STREET – Well Being Check (910):** WMA sleeping in the doorway of a closed store. We conducted a well being check. Individual refused HOT and medical assistance. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **01:05 479 CASTRO STREET – Posted Trespass (MPC25):** WMA sleeping in the doorway of a closed store which had a properly posted MPC-25 No Trespassing sign. We roused the reluctant individual who initially refused to comply with our request, but finally moved to the sidewalk. **DISPOSITION: HAN**
- **01:15 SF MUNI BUS STOP – NORTH WEST CASTRO & MARKET – Intoxicated Person (811):** WMA sitting slumped over in the bus stop with his cell phone on the ground in front of him. Roused the individual and initially he advised he was intending to take the bus home, but a bus arrived and left as we were talking with him and he made no effort to board the bus. He then advised he intended to call an Uber ride home. As he was now conscious, talking with us, and attempting to call an Uber, we advised him we would leave him to it, but would return in fifteen minutes to ensure he had safely left. (We did return and found he had left.) **DISPOSITION: HAN**
- **01:30 HARVEY MILK PLAZA – Open Container (21):** Large group of BMA and BFA in the corner by Soul Cycle with an open container of Tequila. This turned out to be the same group who we encountered earlier in the evening at Walgreens Parking Lot. We admonished them for the alcohol and after some initial resistance and back-talk, they complied advising they would leave. They left in different directions. **DISPOSITION: ADM**
- **01:40 WALGREENS PARKING LOT – COLLINGWOOD ENTRANCE – Intoxicated Person (811):** BMA sitting on the wall of the lot, slumped over.

As we approached we observed two glass crack pipes in his hands, but he was “sleeping” as we approached. We roused him and he immediately began clearing up his paraphernalia and left on foot. We advised him that SFPD has foot patrol Officers in the area so this type of activity sitting under a street light by a busy parking lot would probably result in his arrest next time. **DISPOSITION: ADM**

- **01:45 454 CASTRO STREET – Intoxicated Person (811):** HMA was sitting on the sidewalk, slumped over, with two more sober HMA’s attending to him. We approached to ensure the intoxicated individual was ok, and that he knew the two “helpers.” Intoxicated individual eventually roused enough to confirm that he knew the two HMA’s providing assistance, and they advised they were going to get him something to eat then take an Uber home. **DISPOSITION: NCR**
- **02:00 TEAM DEMOBILIZED**
